
Intrusive Investigations



- Random arrangement of flints, all different


- Some loose, some rigid

- Small flint chippings in the trial hole, primarily flaking off the flints above




Plan of Intrusive Investigations

General Notes

- Random arrangement of flints, all different
- The mortar is mainly light brown, very crumply and flaky
- Some flints are cracked and fall apart very easily
- Small flint chippings in the trial hole, primarily flaking off the flints above
- Outer skin of knapped flint added at a later
- Victorian foundation under over skinned area of the wall, unknown what the older part of the wall is built on
